77. PLANNING

RESOLVED

- (1) it be noted that the Vice-Chairman chaired the meeting for this item of business, as the Chairman had previously declared an interest and did not speak or vote on the belowmentioned planning applications;
- (2) that no objections or comments be submitted to the Borough Council in respect of the 6 applications (numbers 19/02130/FUL, 19/01246/FUL, 19/01942/FUL, 19/02120/FUL 19/02288/FUL and 19/01843/FUL) for planning permission to carry out development in Armthorpe, which had been submitted to Doncaster Borough Council since the last meeting of the Parish Council.

78. WARD MEMBERS' REPORTS

RESOLVED that Ward Councillors C.J. McGuinness, S.L. McGuinness and F.J. Tyas be thanked for reporting and supplying information regarding:-

- utility companies wanting to undertake works in the highway will have to obtain a licence from Doncaster Council before they can start the work;
- (2) grass cutting in the Borough is now working to schedule;
- (3) the Borough Council's Planning Officers were looking into the question of whether free public car parking had been agreed for the new Aldi Supermarket, Church Street;
- (4) Flybe has cancelled its contracts with Doncaster Sheffield Airport; and
- (5) it would cost £350m to alter the East Coast Main Railway
 Line to provide a station at the airport, for which airport
 management had spent £150,000 on preparing a business
 plan that would eventually cost £3.5m in total.

79. GRANTS TO OUTSIDE BODIES

RESOLVED that in accordance with its powers under Section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972, the Parish Council should incur the following sums, as in the Parish Council's opinion, the payments are in the interests of the area or part of it or all or some of its inhabitants and will benefit them in a manner commensurate with the expenditure:-

- (1) AEDdonate £1,500 towards a defibrillator for installation in the centre of the village
- (2) Children with Cancer UK £200

80. DMBC - VARIOUS MATTERS

RESOLVED that Doncaster Borough Council be requested to:-

- (1) arrange for conifers overhanging the footway at 9 Mere Lane, to be cut back;
- (2) consider whether a 'one way in and one way out 'system for vehicles entering and leaving the car park at the Aldi Supermarket site, will solve the traffic problem on Church Street caused with vehicles entering and leaving the Jet Filling Station.
