86. PLANNING

RESOLVED it be noted that no applications for planning permission to carry out development in Armthorpe, had been submitted to Doncaster Borough Council since the last meeting of the Parish Council.

87. EDENTHORPE NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

RESOLVED that no objections or comments be made to Doncaster Borough Council in respect of the Edenthorpe Neighbourhood Development Plan.

88. WARD MEMBERS' REPORTS

RESOLVED that Ward Councillors S.L. McGuinness and F.J. Tyas be thanked for reporting and supplying information regarding:-

- (1) the Acorn public house, Hatfield Lane being boarded up and its intended future use was unknown;
- (2) TUI is expanding with an additional aircraft and two new routes to Greece and Lithuania from summer 2020, meaning a minimum of 136,000 passengers would be flying out of Doncaster Sheffield Airport;
- (3) grass cutting in the Borough is still not working to schedule;
- (4) a planning application had been submitted to the Borough Council for the installation of the Doncaster Mining Statue and Sculpture in Printing Office Street at the junction with St. Sepulchre Gate;
- (5) the Borough Council's Planning Department had received a "framework vision document", regarding a proposal for residential development at Grange Farm by Miller Homes, which the Parish Council had specifically excluded from its Armthorpe Neighbourhood Development Plan;
- (6) the Borough Council were still looking into the question of whether free public car parking had been agreed for the new Aldi Supermarket and the possibility of changing road markings to solve the traffic problem on Church Street;
- (7) sections of knee rails were to be replaced with composite knee rails on the grass verges on Tranmoor Lane, in order to prevent vehicular parking on the same.

89. GRANTS TO OUTSIDE BODIES

RESOLVED

- (1) that the contents of an email be noted from AEDdonate thanking the Council for its donation of £1,500, towards the cost of a defibrillator to be sited in the village at a location to be determined;
- (2) that in accordance with its powers under Section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972, the Parish Council should incur the sum of £200 to Mansfield Crescent and Basil Avenue Neighbourhood Watch Scheme, as in the Parish Council's opinion, the payment is in the interests of the area or part of it or all or some of its inhabitants and will benefit them in a manner commensurate with the expenditure.

90. 'ATC SUNDAY'

RESOLVED that 1053 (Armthorpe) Squadron RAF Air Cadets be thanked for the invitation to attend its 'ATC Sunday' event to be held in February 2020, which Members of the Council would be pleased to attend subject to their availability once the date is known.

91. TREE PLANTING

RESOLVED

- (1) that the contents of emails be noted from (a) a local resident (SG) regarding planting additional trees in Armthorpe; and (b) the Yorkshire Local Councils Associations regarding a Tree Charter Day and the offer of free trees available to parish councils from the Woodland Trust;
- (2) that SG be advised to contact Doncaster Borough Council, as the Parish Council does not own any land in the parish suitable for additional trees to be planted;
- (3) that the Borough Council be asked to suggest any areas within the parish where additional trees could be planted, if the Parish Council obtains free trees available from the Woodland Trust.

92. TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – EDWARD STREET

RESOLVED that the proposed Temporary Order to prohibit through traffic/parking or waiting on Edward Street from 0800 hours on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2019 to 1800 hours on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019, whilst resurfacing works are undertaken to the carriageway, be noted.
