Armthorpe Parish Council is publishing the second version of the Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan. Some *minor* changes have been included since Armthorpe householders, businesses and statutory agencies, such as the Highways Agency, Environment Agency, Natural England, etc. were last consulted in February/March 2014.

- **sites for building about 740 houses**
- **sites for employment and business uses**
- **highways and transport**

- **leisure and community facilities**
